

MARINETTE CIVIC AFFAIRS, CEMETERY, TRAFFIC & LIGHTS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES FROM 09/17/18

1. Alderperson Jason Flatt, Committee Chairperson, **called** the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic and Lights Committee regular meeting **to order** at 05:00 PM in the Marinette Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave, Marinette WI.
2. **Upon a call of the roll**, the following Committee members attendance was recorded as follows:

3. **Approving Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee prior month meeting minutes.**
Alderpersons Noppenberg moved/ Kowalski seconded and all concurred, to approve, as presented, (with the exception of Alderperson Polzin being absent) the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee regular meeting minutes from 8/20/18.
4. **Discussion and possible recommendation to the Common Council to authorize a Resolution to consolidate three City of Marinette municipal voting locations in to one voting polling site for November 6th, 2018 Fall General Election (see attached).**
Alderpersons Kowalski moved/ Polzin seconded and all concurred to recommend the Common Council **approve** the Resolution to consolidate three City of Marinette municipal voting locations in to one voting polling site for November 6th, 2018 Fall General Election.
5. **Discussion and possible action regarding a request for a stop sign at Leonard and Alimeda Streets (see attached).** Police Chief Mabry handed out a criteria sheet to the members which showed there were no accidents/crashes reported at the intersection. At this point the committee feels there is no action needed but will continue to monitor the concerns and watch data and if a change needs to be made they will look further into the Intersection. Frank Korchack of 515 Bay View St spoke in opposition of the placement of a stop sign as he stated there is already a 4 -way stop on Leonard and Cushman which is about 500 feet away.
6. **Continued discussion and possible recommendation to the Common Council to install a traffic light at the intersection of Hall Avenue and Jefferson St. (presentation by Brian Miller, City Engineer).**
Public Works Director Miller talked with the DOT and they both agreed that on a trial basis the Traffic signal on Jefferson St can be bagged to provide time for the Police Dept to see how traffic responds and bring information and data collection back to the committee to see if the traffic Signal should be removed or look at other options. Alderperson Kowalski moved/ Polzin seconded and all concurred to **approve** the request to bag the Traffic Signal on Jefferson St on a temporary basis to collect information and data.
7. **Adjournment** – Alderpersons Walters moved/Noppenberg seconded and all concurred to adjourn at 5:20PM.
