## CLERK'S OFFICE

### FILING DEADLINE TO GET NAME ON SPRING BALLOT

The following Municipal offices are on the ballot for the April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Spring Election in Marinette for 3-year terms: Office of Alderperson for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and At-Large Wards.

Individuals interested in placing their name on the Spring ballot for any of the above listed offices should contact the City Clerk's office, 1905 Hall Avenue, Marinette, WI 54143 or call 715-732-5140. Nomination papers can't be circulated prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

Deadline for filing nomination papers for these offices is 5:00PM, Friday, January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022. New terms for Offices of Alderperson commence on Tuesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022.



## PUBLIC WORKS

### FALL CLEAN UP

Please follow the options listed below when disposing of your yard waste this fall.

Use of plastic bags to dispose of yard waste is prohibited. For more information on fall clean up contact the Public Works Department at 715-732-5134.

- Deposit yard waste into designated paper yard waste bags (50lb. Max weight limit). These bags can be purchased at a number of local retail outlets. Place them by the curb on **Monday** of yard waste week by **6AM** so it can be picked up some time that week.
- Deposit yard waste in designated yard waste containers, not to exceed 32-gallon capacity.
- Shred and mulch yard waste for mixing into your existing gardens and flower beds.
- Haul yard waste to the City compost dump on Cleveland Avenue (either lose or in approved bags) on Wednesday or Saturday mornings (schedule is on back calendar).
- You may also drop yard waste off at the 24/7 drop site located at the dump at 2411 Cleveland Avenue.

**REMINDER: DO NOT RAKE OR BLOW LEAVES INTO ROADWAY**

**Mercury Recycling to Protect Our Environment!**

As part of our efforts to keep Mercury out of the environment, the Marinette Wastewater Treatment Plant is proud to offer our low cost mercury recycling program. The most common mercury containing devices found in the home today is in all fluorescent lightbulbs as well as older home heating thermostats.

Please call The Water Utility at 715-732-5180 if you have any questions between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm.

The charges for recycling are as follows: 4 foot, Circular, U-Shape: \$0.25/bulb; 5 foot and over: \$0.60/bulb; Compact Fluorescent: \$0.55/bulb; HID bulbs (High Pressure Sodium) (Mercury Vapor) (Metal Halide): \$1.15/bulb
