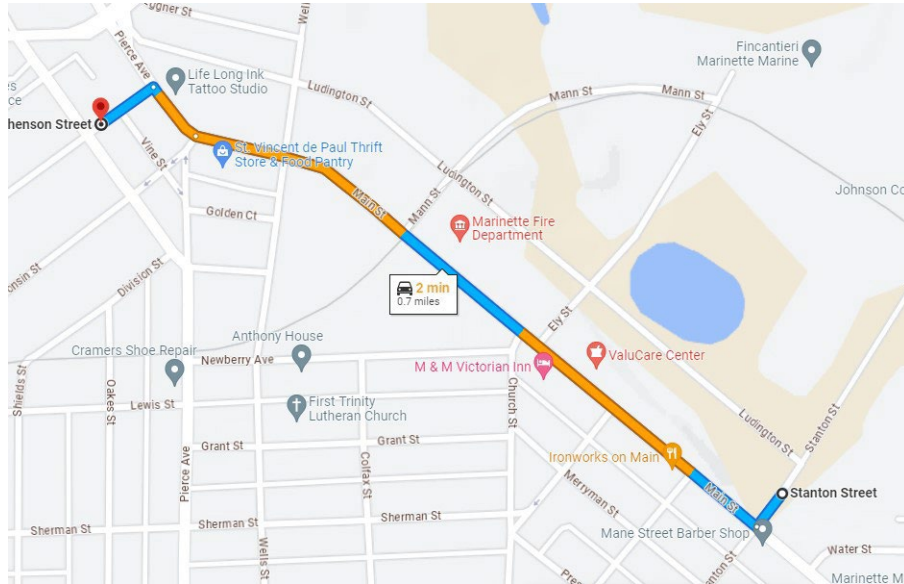

Parade Line-up Staging starting at 4:00PM in Stanton St. & Main Parking Lot. Semis & Large Trucks stage on Ludington and onto Stanton St. Emergency Vehicles are first in line-up, nearest Main Street on Stanton. Parade begins at 5:00PM from Stanton onto Main Street down to Liberty Street. Disburse safely once on Liberty and be mindful of additional entries behind yours.

ALL ENTRIES WILL BE GIVEN A LINE-UP NUMBER EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES. NOTE: LINE-UP NUMBER MAY VARY SLIGHTLY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PARADE COMMITTEE.

SANTA will be the last unit in the parade. There should be no other "Santas". The route is approximately 3/4 mile. MERCHANTS PARK TREE LIGHTING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING PARADE.

- The intent of the City of Marinette's Christmas Parade is for participants of all ages to have fun.
- Placement within the parade lineup is at the discretion of the Parade Coordinators.
- The themes conveyed should be understandable by children and appropriate for viewing by children.
- The Parade is intended to be an entertaining, local event to share with all in helping celebrate the Christmas/Holiday Season.
- All participants, in consideration of this event, agree to indemnify, hold harmless and release the City of Marinette, its agents and employees, from any and all liability for any injury or damage which may arise out of or in any way be connected with participation in the Christmas Parade.
- Any animal units must provide their own "clean-up crew" for their unit in the parade.
- There must be an adult on floats where there are children.
- All parade participants shall conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for a family audience of all ages, walk in a peaceful and orderly fashion and participate in a civil manner with respect to other participants and the public.
- Handing out candy or objects to the spectators is permitted by walkers only.
- **NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED:** Alcoholic Beverages are not allowed at the line-up or on the parade route.
- Safety is our primary concern for both participants and spectators.
